Crisis Response Services

- ✓ **Assertive Community Treatment (ACT)** provides community-based rehabilitation and support services for residents of Saratoga, Warren, and Washington Counties who struggle with serious and persistent mental illness
- ✓ **Home-Based Crisis Intervention** provides intensive in-home services for families with children, help them to manage crises, build family relationships, and build life and coping skills
- ✓ **Mobile Crisis Services** provides rapid-response multidisciplinary care to help children, adolescents, and adults avoid unnecessary emergency room visits and hospitalization

Community Services

- ✓ **Prevention and Family Preservation**, intensive programs designed to provide in-home support to keep children safely at home with families
